Grizz Country Land Services is an Indigenous owned and operated company based at Kluskus Lakes, in Lhoosk'uz territory west of Quesnel, founded by Daniel Cupples of Lhoosk'uz Dené. We put local crews on the land for exploration support, field work, and restoration across the central Interior. We know the ground, we show up, and the work stays in the region.

WHAT WE DO

CORE BOX MANUFACTURING

Built in Kluskus Lakes to client dimensions from locally sourced lumber, branded, stacked, and delivered on schedule. When volumes shift, production shifts with them. 5,500+ boxes delivered to Blackwater Mine since spring 2026.

MINE SITE FIELD CREWS

Fish Habitat Offset Project crews at Blackwater: fish salvage and exclusion fencing, coffer dams, habitat structures, pump and water management, spill control, danger tree falling, fire watch, and flagging. Leadhand supervised 12 hour shifts, daily field reports and LEMs, mine ready trucks.

INVASIVE SPECIES REMOVAL

Trained crews May through September working from an integrated pest management approach: mechanical and chemical treatment, mapping and reporting, and follow up so the native plants get room to come back. Familiar with Cariboo terrain and species.

NATIVE PLANTS AND SEED (BUILDING NOW)

Local provenance seed and berry collection across the Cariboo, cleaning and cold stratification, and container grown plugs for reclamation, habitat offsets, and wildfire recovery. Greenhouse in the funding stage; first contract grow planned for 2027.

Crews from the Lhoosk'uz community and neighbouring nations who already know the land. Less travel, faster mobilization, and the money stays in the region. Counts toward Indigenous participation commitments.

MINE READY

Set up the way a large operator expects: safe work procedures, daily hazard assessments, first aid, and paperwork that arrives the same day. Plain quotes, fair rates.

BUILT TO LAST

Every early contract builds toward the long arc: a native plant nursery, restoration crews, and multi year stewardship agreements that outlast any single project.
